**NEW BOARD BUSINESS**

Ms. Stoica asked the Health Director if the Board could consider implementing regulations for massage parlors. The Health Director explained that massage parlors are strictly enforced by the State and the local Boards of Health cannot override that.

**OLD BOARD BUSINESS**

**17 Harris Street - Update**

The Health Director informed the Board that the property was inspected last Tuesday and a lot of cleanup has been done to the property. There is still more work to be done and the property owner has been given a sixty day extension, at which that point the property will be inspected again.

**Nail Regulations – updated regulations for review**

The Public Hearing for the nail regulations will be held on April 1, 2019 at the Fire State at 5pm.

Issues were brought to the Health Directors attention regarding Main Street Chinese. The Health Director explained that from this complaint an additional inspection was triggered and during the inspection, a few critical violations were logged. Another inspection will take place randomly later this week with the Food Inspector to confirm the violations have been rectified. The Health Agent also confirmed, that the issues at Planet Fitness have been taken care of accordingly as well as a review of sanitation at East Main Café that was from a complaint. No issues were found at the time of the inspection for East Main Café, therefore a review of sanitation was discussed.

Ms. Stoica asked for an update with the abundance of dogs possibly not licensed and dogs defecating at the Sitkowski Apartments. The Health Director did send a letter to the management at the Sitkowski Apartments and as of yet has not

heard back from them. The Town Clerks office will potentially have an online system next fiscal year to keep track of all licensed dogs in the Town of Webster.

The monthly Nurse report was reviewed and discussed.

Mr. Zalewski requested a monthly report from the Animal Control Officer.
