**BOARD OF SELECTMEN
REGULAR SESSION MEETING MINUTES
May 13, 2018**

MEETING OPENING: At 5:30 p.m., Chairman Jolda called the meeting to order. The following individuals were present: Chairman Andrew Jolda, Vice Chairman Randall Becker, Selectman Donald Bourque, Selectman Lisa Kontoes, Selectman Earl Gabor, Town Administrator Douglas Willardson, and Executive Secretary Courtney Friedland. The Board stood and took the Pledge of Allegiance.

BOARD OF SELECTMEN'S FUTURE MEETING DATES: Selectman Becker stated the Board might hold a meeting prior to the proposed June 10th meeting to go over agendas, proposed meeting dates and to reorganize. He suggested the Board meet May 20, 2019, at 6:00 p.m. Mr. Willardson stated Attorney Hewig will come to the June 10th meeting to give the Board a legal update.

REVIEW OF THE SPECIAL TOWN MEETING WARRANT: Mr. Willardson went through the Special Town Meeting articles. Selectman Becker asked if article number 14 would be necessary if the town would have been proactive in doing the work. Mr. Willardson stated this is now mandated by the State and the town might want to look at the percentage of water increase for next year. Selectman Kontoes asked what the upgrade consisted of for article 14. She stated this is a lot of money for LED screens. Mr. Willardson stated they currently have one quote off of the State bid list. They will go out for two more quotes before the equipment is purchased. He stated the money cannot be used for anything else than PEG Access.

REVIEW OF ANNUAL TOWN MEETING WARRANT: Mr. Willardson stated all articles have remained the same. He stated he would like to address article 20. He stated he spoke with the Chief of Police and Harbormaster today. They suggested holding off on the article for one more year. He stated the by-law did not have an effect on the control of jet skis. He stated they will increase patrols and see if that will make a difference.

Motion by Selectman Becker, seconded by Selectman Bourque, to recommend passing over for more information on article 20. The motion passed unanimously

ONE DAY LIQUOR LICENSE REQUEST FOR STS. CONSTANTINE & HELEN CHURCH:
