1. Request for “Slow Children” sign on Victoria Dr.
 - Requested by resident Richard Milas
 - Discussion with Google Street View map of area
 - Mr. Avlas motioned to place two (2) “Slow Children” signs, one in each direction, seconded by Chief Shaw.
2. Request for placement of “No Parking” signs on Poland St., near New St.
 - Resident Patricia Mendillo requests signage due to alleged on going parking issues with vehicles parked on both sides of the street.
 - Discussion
 - Chief Shaw suggests that Police monitor the area for parking issues prior to the next meeting
 - Mr. Avlas suggests that matter be delieverd back to Ms. Mendillo for further information, such as her suggestions on which side she would like to see parking limited.
 - Mr. Pizzetti will call Ms. Mendillo and request recommendations
3. Request for portion of Point Pleasant Rd. be designated as “One Way.”
