RE: Warrants issued for armed robberies

On November 18, at about 8:30 pm, a woman walked in to the Himalaya Wok at 68 East Main Street, while masked, and brandished a knife demanding money. She made off with over \$250. Police were unable to locate her that night, however some evidence was recovered and an investigation by the police ensued.

On November 19, the following day at 8:30 am, a woman walked into Gilbert's Market, located at 95 North Main Street, masked, brandished a knife, and demanded money. No money was received and she left. Again evidence was recovered as well as surveillance video. Webster Police Detective Steven Cacciapouti, after a month long investigation, filed charges against Jean Lane, 31 years old, with a last known address of 15 Dudley Road in Oxford.

Lane was charged with Armed Robbery while masked for the Himalaya Wok robbery, and Assault with the intent to rob for the Gilbert's Market attempted robbery. A warrant for her arrest was issued by the Dudley District Court.


