RE: Arrest made on two armed robberies and one attempted armed robbery

On December 25th at a 1916 hours, a female walked into the Sunoco Gas station on East Main Street and demanded money, indicating she had a gun, in an attempt to rob the store. No money was given at that time.

The same day at 1922 hours, the same person walked into Walgreen's Pharmacy and demanded money, also indicating she had a firearm. She was given an undisclosed amount of money, and efforts to locate her at that time were unsuccessful.

No firearm was ever shown on either occasion, and surveillance photos and video were recovered and an investigation was commenced.

On December 28th at 1855 hours, a call was made to the Webster Police Department from The Main Street Chinese Restaurant where a female was causing a disturbance and said to have a handgun. Police arrived to find a female being detained by workers and what was later determined to be a toy handgun spray painted black to look real on a table. The female was later identified as Carly Fifield, 22 Robinson Street #2 Webster, 27. She was wearing a mask at the time and did display the replica gun and demanded money. At that time she was subdued by staff until police arrived moments later.

As a result of the incident Fifield was charged with the following:

Assault to Rob while armed, threatening to commit a crime, and arrestee furnishing a false name.

After some investigation, it was determined Fifield committed the above two acts and was charged with Armed Assault to Rob with a Firearm for the Sunoco incident
