RE: Shooting

Date: January 7, 2015

On January 6th at approximately 8:50 pm, Webster Police and EMS responded to an apartment on High Street for a report of a male that had sustained a gunshot wound to the leg. Police arrived and found a 42 year old man had been shot once in the leg. Police were told two tall, thin, black males had entered the residence of the male and a scuffle ensued resulting in the male victim sustaining gunshot wound to the leg. The males then fled the scene. Oxford Police K9 was called in to assist, but it is believed the suspects left in a vehicle. Police are not releasing the victim's name at this time. The injuries were not considered life threatening and the victim was transported to UMass in Worcester. Webster Police Detective Sergeant James Hoover is investigating and anyone with any information is asked to contact the Webster Police Department at 508-943-1212. The police do not believe that the public is at risk as it is believed this was an isolated incident. Anonymous tips can also be left at 508-949-3874.
