On Tuesday January 31, 2006, the Webster Police Department responded to a hold up alarm at Varos Jewelry store located in the East Main St. Plaza. Two white males had entered the store. One male approached the counter and spoke with the clerk, saying he was just browsing. The male then put his hand in his coat pocket pointed it at the owner. The owner believed he had a gun inside. The suspect handed the owner a black trash bag and told him to start filling it. The suspect told the owner to hurry up. The owner's wife came out from the back and interrupted the robbery. The two suspects then fled on foot into the plaza parking. The suspects made off with a large amount of jewelry, i.e.: diamond rings, men's rings, bracelets and necklaces, some with colored stones.

The first male is described as white, approximately 5'10" tall, muscular build, 220lbs, wearing a black jacket with a hood, jeans, black short hair, and facial hair as if not shaven for a couple of days.

The second male is described as white, approximately 5'8" tall, thin build; wear a light colored jacket, jeans, short hair, clean-shaven and wearing a baseball cap.
