On August 7, at approximately 1944 hours, Webster Police Officers received a BOLO (Be On the Look Out) for an erratic operator that had actually sat through numerous cycles at a traffic light in Dudley. The license plate given was the same that the Connecticut State Police had been looking for earlier, as it was alleged to have been involved in a motor vehicle accident in their state.

Officer Bruce Hamm located the vehicle while on patrol and stopped it on South Main Street in Webster. After stopping it, he saw that it was smoking, and later determined it was steam from another crash that had occurred in another town. Douglas Police would call saying that he vehicle had been involved in a motor vehicle accident in their town as well, and actually had a mirror and bumper, presumably from the car Officer Hamm had stopped.

After conducting field sobriety tests, the operator, Daria Lay, 40 11 Deborah Road Worcester, was arrested for Operating under the influence of alcohol, negligent operation of a motor vehicle, and operating a motor vehicle with a suspended license.

Once back at the Webster Police Department, Ms. Lay took and registered a .29 on the Breathalyzer Test.

Ms. Lay was released on \$40 bail for an arraignment in Dudley District Court today.
