RE: House Break Arrest

Date: April 25, 2018

On April 24, at approximately 0830 Webster Police received a call for a house alarm at 2 Riverside Drive. Upon police arrival, it was discovered that the house had in fact been broken into. Alert residents reported seeing people running towards St. Josephs Cemetery. A message was also received via Facebook reporting that two people had been seen in the area of the construction pits in close proximity to the address. That Information was relayed to the officers in the area and two people were subsequently located on Normandy Avenue, containing property believed to be taken from the address.

After a brief investigation, it was discovered that the male, Patrick Salvas had broken into the house and a removed the property he was found with. He was transported back to the station, where he was also found to be in possession of heroin, in an amount that appeared to be packaged consistent with someone that sells it.

Salvas was charged the following:

- Breaking and Entering in the Daytime with the Intent to Commit a Felony
- Larceny from a building
- Wantonly Injuring Real or Personal Property
- Possession of a Class A Substance
- Possession of a Class A Substance with the intent to Distribute

He was held at the police station on \$5040, pending an arraignment at Dudley District Court today.

There are charges forthcoming on a second person, which will be sought through the Dudley District Court.
