RE: Update on Abduction/Assault

Date: June 4, 2019

On May 31st a 12 year old female rode her bicycle to the May Street Park to meet a friend. At this time she was approached by a male in a car, and enticed to go with him under the guise of needing help with a friend. She went with the male and was subsequently taken to what we believe is a location over the state line in Connecticut, where she was sexually assaulted. She was then believed to have been dropped off somewhere in the vicinity of Chase Avenue in Dudley, where she ran to a resident's home and contacted her mother.

The description of the vehicle given was a black, two door car with a light interior. The male was described as being white, with blonde hair, and having a "skinny" face. He is also described as having light facial hair growth at the time of the incident.

Webster Police Detectives are working with Detectives from the Connecticut State Police, as well the District Attorney's Office. Webster Police are asking anyone with information to call 508-943-1212, or email crimetips@websterpolice.com Police are also asking that if anyone has any surveillance video, or still pictures from the area of May Street Park from 2:30 pm to 3:30 pm to contact the Webster Police Department so that they can be viewed. Police are also asking that anyone with surveillance video or still photos of Lake Parkway and/or Thompson Road from 2:30 pm to 4:30 pm contact Police so they can be viewed.
