Pursuant to Governor Baker's March 12, 2020 Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law, G.L. c. 30A, §18, and the Governor's March 15, 2020 Order imposing strict limitation on the number of people that may gather in one place, this meeting of the Webster Board of Selectmen will be conducted via remote participation to the greatest extent possible. Specific information and the general guidelines for remote participation by members of the public and/or parties with a right and/or requirement to attend this meeting can be found on the Town's website, at [www.webster-ma.gov](http://www.webster-ma.gov). Limited in-person attendance of members of the public will be permitted, but every effort will be made to ensure that the public can adequately access the proceedings in real time, via technological means. For this meeting, members of the public who wish to watch the meeting may do so via Zoom. Those who would like to participate in or watch the meeting, must pre-register by 4:00PM on June 14th, by emailing [support@webster-ma.gov](mailto:support@webster-ma.gov) and request access to the meeting. This is necessary to avoid any interruptions by "Zoom bombers." If unable to pre-register, despite best efforts, we will post on the town's website an audio or video recording, transcript, or other comprehensive record of proceedings as soon as possible after the meeting. *On February 15, 2022, Governor Baker signed into law a new session law extending certain COVID-19 related measures. The new law, Chapter 22 of the Acts of 2022, includes an extension until July 15, 2022, of the remote meeting provisions of the Governor's March 12, 2020,*
