**MEETING OPENING** At 6:00 p.m., Chairman Gabor called the meeting to order and announced the following individuals were present via vonage: Chairman Earl Gabor, Vice-Chairman Thomas Klebart, Secretary Randy Becker, Selectman Mark Rogers and Executive Assistant Kelly Lyman.

Chairman Gabor referred to the March 12, 2020, Governor Baker Executive Order modifying certain requirements of the Open Meeting Law, to enable public bodies to carry out their responsibilities while adhering to public health recommendations regarding social distancing as fully stated on the agenda. As further explained on the agenda, the Executive Order relieves public bodies from the requirement in the Open Meeting Law that meetings be conducted in a public place that is open and physically accessible to the public, provided that the public body makes provision to ensure public access to the deliberations of the public body through adequate, alternative means. On March 29, 2023 Governor Healy signed an extension of this law. The new law, an Act Relative to Extending Certain State of Emergency Accommodations, includes an extension until March 31, 2025, of the remote meeting provisions of the Governor's March 12, 2020, Executive Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law.

**REQUEST AND POSSIBLE VOTE TO APPROVE THE ONE-DAY LICENSE APPLICATION FOR ST. CONSTANTINE AND HELEN'S GREEK ORTHODOX CHURCH FOR A FUNDRAISER ON JUNE 3, 2023**

There were no other individuals attending the meeting on Vonage.

**Motion by Selectman Klebart, seconded by Selectman Becker to approve the "One-Day" liquor license application submitted by St. Constantine and Helen's Greek Orthodox Church for a fundraiser to be held on June 3, 2023 from 11:00 am – 6:00 pm. Chairman Gabor mentioned that the Selectmen should review the deadline for submittals for the One-Day license applications, in order to prevent having separate remote meetings so often. That could be added to a future agenda as we review the Selectmen Policies.
