**MEETING OPENING:** At 6:00 p.m., Vice-Chairman Jolda called the meeting to order in the Selectmen's Meeting Room, Webster Town Hall, 350 Main Street, Webster, MA. The following individuals were present: Selectman Andrew Jolda (via Zoom meeting), Selectman Earl Gabor (via Zoom meeting), Selectman Thomas Klebart (via Zoom meeting), Recreation Director Carole Marchand (via Zoom meeting), and Executive Assistant Courtney Friedland (via Zoom meeting). The Board stood and took the Pledge of Allegiance.

Vice-Chairman Jolda stated on March 12, 2020, Governor Baker issued an Executive Order modifying certain requirements of the Open Meeting Law, to enable public bodies to carry out their responsibilities while adhering to public health recommendations regarding social distancing as fully stated on the agenda. As further explained on the agenda, the Executive Order relieves public bodies from the requirement in the Open Meeting Law that meetings be conducted in a public place that is open and physically accessible to the public, provided that the public body makes provision to ensure public access to the deliberations of the public body through adequate, alternative means. On June 16, 2021, Governor Baker signed into law An Act Extending Certain COVID-19 Measures Adopted During the State of Emergency. This Act includes an extension, until April 1, 2022, of the remote meeting provisions of his March 12, 2020, Executive Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law.

Vice-Chairman Jolda announced the name of each attendee who attended via Zoom.

**BUMSKI'S LLC DBA BUMSKI'S MOBILE BAR – "ONE DAY" LIQUOR LICENSURE REQUEST:**

Vice-Chairman Jolda stated the Board of Selectmen received a request from Bumski's, LLC dba Bumski's Mobile Bar for a "One Day" liquor license for Saturday, September 25, 2021 for the Food Truck Festival being held at Memorial Beach. Ms. Marchand thanked the Board of Selectmen for meeting on such short notice. The vendor was unaware that a local license was needed for the event.

Motion by Selectmen Klebart, seconded by Selectman Gabor to approve the “One Day” liquor license submitted by Bumski’s, LLC dba Bumski’s Mobile Bar, 1142 Farmington Ave. West Hartford, CT 06107 for the Food Truck Festival, Memorial Beach Drive, Webster, MA on Saturday, September 25, 2021 from 12:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.
