

**SITE ASSIGNMENT  
PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE  
TOWN OF WEBSTER  
BOARD OF HEALTH**

In accordance with Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 111, Sections 150A and 150A½ and the regulations promulgated thereunder (310 CMR 16.00 "Site Assignment Regulations for Solid Waste Facilities"), an Application for Site Suitability for a Major Modification of an Existing Site Assignment (the "Application") has been filed with the Webster Board of Health (BOH) for the site assignment of a solid waste handling facility to be located at 56 Worcester Road to 64 Worcester Road, Webster, MA 01570 (Assessor's Maps 87-A-1-0 and 87-A-1-1).

On January 25, 2021 at 5:30 P.M. (and in the event additional time is required the hearing will continue and be held on February 1, 2021 at 7:00 P.M.), the BOH will hold a public hearing (in accordance with 310 CMR 16.20) at the Webster Town Hall, Board of Selectmen Room, 350 Main Street, Webster, MA to consider the Application. The public hearing will be conducted via Zoom and information on how to access the meeting will be available on the Town of Webster website as set forth below. Anyone wishing to join the meeting and/or participate must follow the instructions below.

The site being considered at 64 Worcester Road consists of approximately 0.39 acres, is located entirely within Industrial Zoning District and will be used as an expansion of an already permitted 0.39 acre solid waste handling facility located at 56 Worcester Road (collectively, the "Facility") all of which would be located upon the contiguous 18.67 acre combined parcels. Specifically, the Facility will be an expansion of the permitted medical waste transfer facility and will handle the transportation of up to 49 tons per day of prepackaged medical waste, which will occur in a covered area on a concrete loading dock over asphalt pavement, and operate from 7:30am to 6pm, Monday through Saturday.

The Applicant is Kunkel Bus Co. Inc., a Massachusetts corporation with an address of 870 School Street, Webster, MA 01570. The operator of the Facility is United Medical Waste Management, Inc., a Massachusetts corporation with an address of 20 Oakhurst Road, Sutton, MA 01590.

The Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has issued a Site Suitability Report, dated September 4, 2020, in which it determined that the above-described site is a suitable place for the proposed Facility. Copies of the Application, DEP's Report and the site suitability criteria (310 CMR 16.00) are available for copying and examination at the offices of the BOH, 350 Main Street, Webster, MA, Monday through Thursday between the hours of 8:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M and are available at [www.webster-ma.gov](http://www.webster-ma.gov).

No less than seven (7) days prior to the opening of the public hearing, any individual or groups wishing to participate in the hearing shall be required to submit by hand-delivery or mail to the BOH (350 Main Street, Webster, MA 01570) and the Hearing Officer (John F. Shea, Esq., Mackie Shea Durning, 20 Park Plaza Suite 1001, Boston, MA 02116, [js@lawmso.com](mailto:js@lawmso.com)), a registration statement (signed under the pains and penalties of perjury) setting forth the following information:

<sup>a</sup> Name and Address of the party seeking to intervene; and

<sup>b</sup> Party status (abutter/group of abutters/ten citizen group); and

<sup>c</sup> Name, address and contact information for any Authorized Representative of the Party; and

<sup>d</sup> Abutters also must provide a description of the abutting property including the boundaries, current use, and a sworn statement that the party registering holds title to the property; or

<sup>e</sup> 10-Citizen group/intervenor also must provide a detailed statement as to how the group/intervenor will be substantially and specifically affected by the Facility; and

Prior to filing a registration statement, any individual desiring to be an intervenor at the public hearing must file a petition with the Hearing Officer no less than fourteen (14) days prior to the opening of the public hearing, requesting approval to intervene and leave to file a registration statement.

Anyone wishing to attend and/or participate in the public hearing via Zoom must also pre-registered by January 25, 2021 by 3:00 PM by emailing [health.department@webster-ma.gov](mailto:health.department@webster-ma.gov) to request access to the meeting.
