## **Press Release**

At approximately 6:02am on September 11, 2010, Officers from the Webster and Dudley Police Departments with the assistance of the South Worcester County Drug and Counter Crime Task Force and Central Massachusetts Law Enforcement Council SWAT Team executed three narcotics search warrants. Two warrants were executed in Webster and the third was executed in Dudley. These search warrants were the result of a month long investigation by the Webster Police Dept. Detective Bureau and Officers from the Dudley Police Dept.

All three warrants were executed simultaneously utilizing the swat team to make the entries. The two locations in Webster were 54 Lake St., 1<sup>st</sup> floor and 41 Main St., apt. #1. The residence in Dudley was 4 Laprise Court, 1<sup>st</sup> floor.

As a result of the 54 Lake St. warrant officers seized a quantity of marijuana, a quantity of crack cocaine, US currency, packaging materials, scales, and a stun gun. In addition officers found a marijuana plant growing on the back porch of the residence and several plant pots in the basement that was evidence of a small marijuana manufacturing / cultivation operation.

Arrested at this location were David Nicholopoulos, DOB 03/10/56; Kathleen Nicholopoulos, DOB 10/06/54; and Jorge Murphy, DOB 11/01/88. All are residents of 54 Lake St.

As a result of the 41 Main St., Apt. 1 warrant officers seized a large quantity of marijuana, a large quantity of crack cocaine, US currency, packaging materials, and scales.

Arrested at this location was resident Lashawn Dismuke DOB 05/29/68.

As a result of the 4 Laprise Ct., 1<sup>st</sup> floor warrant officers seized a quantity of marijuana, a quantity of crack cocaine, US currency, packaging materials, and scales.
