RE: Attempted Armed Robbery – White Hen Pantry Webster

On 10/01/10 at approximately 0116 hrs a lone, white female entered the White Hen Pantry at 95 Main St. in the Town of Webster. The female was dressed in a gray, hooded sweatshirt, black Capri pants, and socks. The two socks appeared to be different colors. The female, was further described as being in her late teens or early twenties, and being 5'1" – 5'3" in height, and having a thin build. She approached the clerk and brandished a knife. She told the clerk to open the drawer and give her the money. The male clerk refused and became engaged in a brief struggle with the female perpetrator. The female perpetrator then fled the scene on foot. The male clerk was uninjured.

Webster Police Officers Bryan Bates, Michael Yurkevicius, and Daniel DiFusco responded to the initial call. K-9 Officer Aaron Suss and his K-9 Red also assisted in the immediate search for the suspect. The Webster Police Department's Detective Bureau is investigating. The Webster Police Department is asking for the public's help in identifying the suspect.
