PRESS RELEASE: 10-01-11

On 10-01-2011 The Webster Police received an initial report of a robbery at the corner of Prospect and Lake Street. The victim reported that a suspect, a tall, thin, white male wearing all black had fled the area on foot after stealing the individual's money. Investigating Officers were able to gather information that the suspect had fled to an apartment complex at the area of Prospect and Short Street.

After interviewing different people at the complex, Officers located an individual matching the suspect description. He was later identified as Shane Davis, 21, of 456 South Main Street, Webster. After providing officers with false information, Davis fled on foot. Additional Officers were able to secure the immediate area so Webster K9 Officer Aaron Suss and his partner Radar could search. Davis was apprehended a short time later while hiding on a second floor porch of a multi-family building on Oak Street.

An unknown resident yelled to the Officers that the suspect was on the porch when they reached the house. Davis was apprehended by Detective Gordon Wentworth, Officer Suss, and K9 Radar. Davis true identity was ascertained and it was confirmed that he was wanted by the Superior Court of the State of Rhode Island for stolen firearm offenses.

Davis was held at the Webster Police Department without bail and charged as a Fugitive from Justice. He was also charged with Disorderly Person, Disturbing the Peace, and Obstruction of Justice. He is to be arraigned in the Dudley District Court.

The initial robbery report was investigated by Detective Wentworth. Investigating Officers learned that the incident involved a narcotics deal gone bad. Detective Wentworth was assisted by Officers Patrick Perry, James Young Sr. and Leonard Gevry in the investigation.
