**Re: Two arrests a result from Search Warrant**

On March 3, 2007 at approximately 1415 hours, members of the Webster Police Department executed a search warrant at 25 Pleasant Street, apartment number 1.

As a result, Police detained three people and eventually arrested two persons, both of whom had drugs on their person. The third person was released once it was determined that there was no reason to hold him.

Taken into custody were the following:

Anne Marie Krasnecky 09/26/59, the renter of the apartment at 25 Pleasant Street. She was charged with the following:

Possession of a Class B Substance (Cocaine) with the intent to distribute

Possession of a Class D Substance (Marijuana)

Possession of a Class B Substance (Cocaine)

James Chenevert 09/20/66, listing an address of 70 Pleasant Street number 6. He was charged with the following:

Possession of a Class B Substance (Cocaine) with the intent to distribute-subsequent offense

Distribution of a Class B Substance (Cocaine) –subsequent offense

Possession of a Class D Substance (Marijuana)

Possession of a Class B Substance (Cocaine) –subsequent offense

Possession of a Class B Substance (OxyContin)

During the search police found various types of packaging materials used to distribute drugs, as well as records of whom had bought the drugs and how much they paid.

Southbridge Police Officer Reddick and his K-9 Mita assisted in the search.

The search warrant was a result of an investigation conducted by Sergeant William Keefe and Detective James Hoover. It began from complaints initiated by anonymous tips and complaints from local businesses.

Assisting in the execution of the search warrant were Officers James Young Sr., Thomas Ralph, Leonard Gevry, and Sergeant Michael Shaw.
