Press Release 03-04-2007

Two men were arrested and one woman suffered minor injuries as a result of an early morning Sunday brawl at the PACC bar in Webster.

According to Webster Officer Aaron Suss, at approximately 1am, the Webster Police Department received a 911 call reporting a large brawl at the PACC barroom on Harris Street. Officers arriving at the scene observed a group of approximately 20 people. Most of suspects fled the area prior to the police arriving, except for another smaller group of combatants, which officers were able to get under control. One suspect, Shawn W. Keenan, 28, of 22 Cutler Street, Webster was immediately placed under arrest while Officers were trying to restore order.

After investigating this incident, police learned that the fight initially broke out between several of the patrons over a game of pool. It started inside the barroom, and later spilled outside into the parking lot. One female patron suffered some minor bruising to her left arm from a still unidentified male suspect. She stated to the officers the suspect threw her to the ground during the fighting inside the bar.

During this incident, Roman Mitchell, 21, of 99 Crystal Street, Southbridge, stole a pocketbook and ran outside in an attempt to hide it under a vehicle. Other patrons witnessed this, and Mitchell was placed under arrest shortly afterwards. Mitchell was also charged in connection with his role in disturbance.

Keenan was charged with Disorderly Person, and Mitchell was charged with Disorderly Person and Larceny. Both were held at the Webster Police Department Lockup and later released on Personal Recognizance. Both will be arraigned in Dudley District Court on Monday morning. Officers Suss, Daniel DiFusco, and Timothy Moran investigated this incident.
